Supreme Commander Kim Jong II, 1991-2011

On December 24, 1991, Korean leader Kim Jong II was appointed as the Supreme Commander of the Korean People's Army. The period of 20 years since then should naturally be called two decades of his brilliant career.

Kim Jong II has built up the defence capabilities of the country to the maximum.

With socialism collapsed in the former Soviet Union and other countries, the United States pretended itself as the "victor in the Cold War" and the allied imperialist forces headed by the US provoked the Gulf War. They were engrossed in high-handed and arbitrary practices in different parts of the world, carried away by the showoff of their "might". Around this Kim Jong II assumed the KPA supreme commandership and took all possible measures for boosting the defence capabilities of the country.
