Great Leader of the WPK

October 10 this year marks the 67th founding anniversary of the Workers' Party of Korea, which is called a mother party by the Korean people.

The supreme leader of the Party is Kim Jong Un, who was elected its First Secretary on April 11 this year.

In his congratulatory speech delivered at the military parade held in celebration of the centenary of the birth of President Kim II Sung on April 15, he said:

"It is the firm determination of our Party to ensure that our people, who are the best in the world and who have remained faithful to the Party in the face of all manner of difficulties, do not have to tighten their belts again, but enjoy all the benefits of socialism."

Love for his people is the starting point of all his thinking and activities and the supreme principle and highest goal of his politics.

After reading a document submitted by officials he wrote on it "Let us serve the people!" and when he toured newly built structures, he reminded officials of their duty as the servants of the people, asking them whether the people like them or not and saying that they must, first of all, serve the convenience of the people, they must be kind to the people that they should make sure that the buildings could attract as many visitors as possible, that nothing should be spared for the good of the people, and that once they have decided to present the people with something, they must present an excellent one. When he visited a funfair, he sternly reprimanded its officials for their improper management of it, saying no matter how many the officials there may be, they are useless, if they do not feel qualm of conscience after they neglected the care of a place for the people and do not value the people.

His ennobling love of the people is unthinkable apart from his thoroughgoing outlook on the people.

He regards the people as the most valuable and powerful beings in the world. "There must be officials and the leader only for the people and they must place trust in the people, masters of the revolution and construction, and rely on them in making revolution"—this is his political philosophy

and life motto.

He urges officials to give the highest and absolute priority to the interests of the people and devote their all to the well-being of the people. It is also a demand on himself.

This is well evidenced by his considerable effort devoted to the construction of the Rungna People's Pleasure Park which was completed this July. He visited the construction site three times in a little more than two months and taught how to build it as a world first-class, general pleasure park. On the day before its inauguration he looked round the minigolf course, the alpa mare and the dolphinarium to ascertain if everything was excellent. The inaugural ceremony of the pleasure park took place in July this year in presence of Kim Jong Un. He expressed great satisfaction over the fact that it was built as an excellent cultural resort for the people, hearing the merry laughter of the visitors.

When he looked round newly built apartment buildings in Changjon Street in downtown Pyongyang, he felt the floor of a house with his hand. When he visited a newly built restaurant, he sat on a chair unceremoniously and referred to the need to strictly follow the principle of ensuring convenience first and aesthetics next in order to give no inconvenience to the people. Seeing that seats for special guests were arranged at the newly built People's Theatre, he ordered officials to remove them, saying that he would enjoy performances on an ordinary chair used by the people.

His love of the people reaches every part of the country–factories, rural communities, villages, schools, kindergartens and nurseries.

He saw to it in early June that chartered planes were sent for delegates to the joint national meeting of the Korean Children's Union. When floods fell on a locality in July he took an emergency measure to dispatch an airplane of the Korean People's Army to save 60 local people. Wherever he went, he posed for photographs with ordinary working people and soldiers, arm in arm and shoulder to shoulder with them.

Deeply moved by his love of them, all the Korean people are full of a determination to remain loyal to his leadership for ever.
